In 1939 my father joined the Army and we moved to Cranbrook. I went to school in Cranbrook and at the age of 18 got married and moved to Nelson. I worked for B.C. Tel and between times had 4 daughters and one son. I also worked part time for the local radio station, doing special programming.

In 1973 my husband and I parted company and I moved to Kamloops. There I worked for B.C. Tel and went to night school and got my pilots license. In 1978 D'Arcy and I moved to Scotch Creek where we both worked for Captain's Village Marina. After 2 years there we set out on our own and moved to Deep Creek where we built the log house of our dreams. While there I went to school and got my ceramics teaching certificate. In 1988 I got interested in spinning and weaving and took many workshops.

In 2002 I hurt my back and it was too difficult to look after 20 acres so we moved to Armstrong and moved in 2003. After joining Zion United Church I worked at the good Food Box, was secretary of council and now I am on the worship committee and the Sunshine Lady. Last year I lost my best friend D'Arcy and now my future is to live until I am 100.
